Firestone Farms was conceived to be a lifestyle community with certain standards for each homeowner as well as amenities for all to enjoy. It was structured under a legal declaration which outlines reasonable rules that must be followed. It is managed by a Board of which I am a member, with advice from the Steering Committee, made up of community members. At some future point, the Steering Committee will take over responsibility and become the Board.

I would like to address several issues regarding the rules.

- 1. POLITICAL SIGNS are prohibited in the community. I was misinformed on this issue because of a Supreme Court ruling declaring that this was unconstitutional for public entities. Our legal declaration takes precedent in this situation.
- 2. BASKETBALL HOOPS shall be located or screened so as to be concealed from view of neighboring residences. This is a difficult issue with numerous basketball hoops already installed improperly, yet some with approval. The steering committee has suggested we try a basketball curfew for 2018 in order to let the kids play, but respect the neighbors. Please end basketball play at 9:00 pm.
- 3. ARCHITECTURAL construction and landscaping plans must be approved prior to the commencement of work, and must comply with community standards. Outbuildings are prohibited.
- 4. BOATS and RECREATIONAL VEHICLES cannot be stored at Firestone Farms except in garages. Cars cannot be parked in the grass.
- 5. POOL USAGE is for members and their guests only. You must be present with your guests. No glass is allowed in the pool area. The pool closes at 9:00. 10pm
- 6. GARBAGE CANS should be stored out of sight or in the garage.

These are some examples of issues that have occurred the last several years. If you have a suggestion for a rule change, please let us know. One thought is to change the pool closing rule to 10:00.

Firestone Farms is a wonderful community with a diverse group of people. It is a retirement community, a family community, a golf course community, a swimming pool community. We must work together, respect each other is rights, and fulfill our responsibilities.
